Difference between Retrofit and Full Tear Out

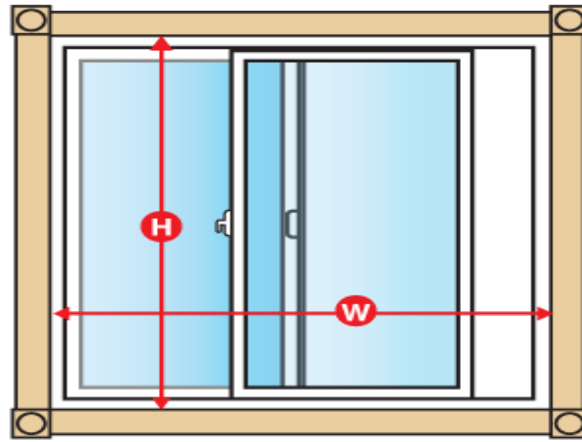
A retrofit, also known as an insert, implies that there is an existing window frame in place. A retrofit installation requires no removal of interior or exterior trim or window covering, so it is less intensive than a full-frame tear-out, making it less expensive. The sashes and stops are removed, but the frame remains. A new window is then installed in the place of the old one, inside the existing frame.

A full-frame window tear-out, as it implies, takes place when the entire window and frame are removed and replaced. This includes brick mould and jamb extensions as necessary. This type of installation includes removal of interior trim and window coverings.

How To Measure Your Windows

For the purpose of obtaining a quote only, measure your existing windows – width x height. Measure the width from trim to trim and then measure the height from trim to trim.





To provide you with a more accurate estimate, we also ask that you select the type of window needed for each room. See following a picture of our most common windows. Various configurations and shapes are possible.

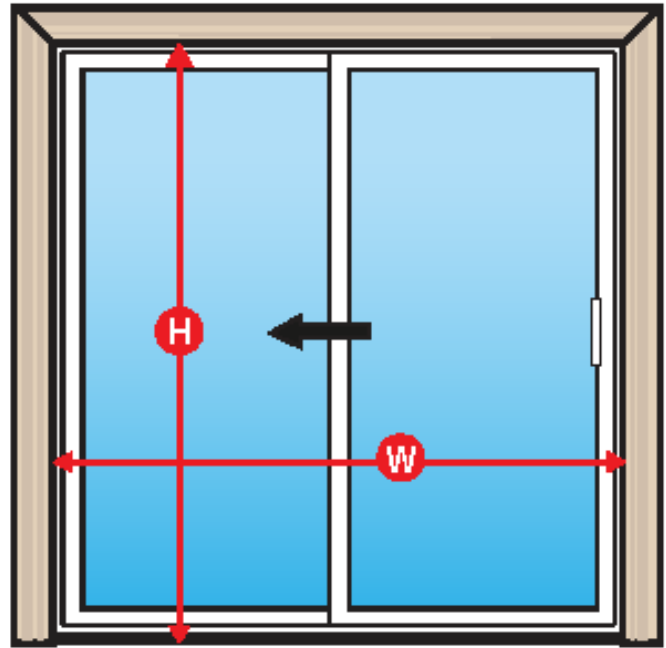
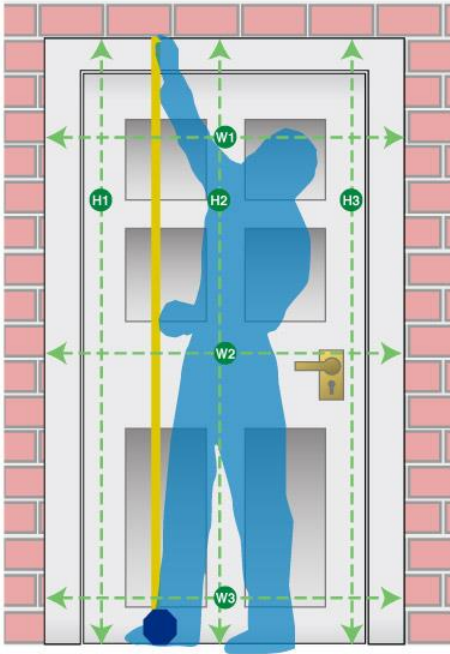
